

For example, the analogy between the Western systems and Hindu Yoga is well known, but up to the present the parallel between them and the initiated Chinese tradition has remained an unsolved enigma. In the Book of Thoth, however, the relationship is firmly and convincingly established, thereby providing a further proof of the validity of both viewpoints.

This is only one of the many achievements of scholarship which mark out this work as a milestone in occult exegesis, but more valuable still is the completely fresh approach to the whole subject which permeates the book.
